## THE SITUATION

---

SINCE 2006, 60,000 AFRICAN MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES IN ISRAEL HAVE BEEN THE TARGET OF ORGANIZED RACIST CAMPAIGNS BY THE GOVERNMENT AND HAVE BEEN THE VICTIMS OF UNWARRANTED VIOLENT ATTACKS. OVER 2,000 ERITREANS AND SUDANESE HAVE BEEN FORCIBLY PLACED IN DESERT DETENTION CAMPS AND CONTINUE TO BE DEPRIVED OF BASIC HUMAN RIGHTS. JOIN US FOR A DISCUSSION ON THIS CRITICAL YET UNDERREPORTED ISSUE THAT AFFECTS THE BLACK COMMUNITY AT LARGE.
